## Outer Sphere (Dharmakaya)


The primal wisdom and absolute reality.



illusion of separateness.


**Eros (Romantic):**




**The Master Plan**

Recognising that trivial disagreements rip the fabric of relationships; wholeheartedness requires setting aside pride to resolve conflict with grace.


## Taking the First Step
